Family Members,

Today we held a facility wide COVID-19 testing date at the North Dakota Veterans Home. If there are any positive tests from today's round of testing, we will send out a notification. To clear up any confusion on who is required to test we want to share what we are directed to do as a facility. Residents and staff are still required to test, even after having the vaccine. Individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19 are not required to test for a 90-day period following their positive test. Once the 90-day period is over they will resume testing. Feel free to reach out to us if you have questions on any of this.
