Family Members,

We are pleased to share with you that the results are in from our March 5th facility-wide COVID-19 testing event and we had no positive results amongst staff and residents.

What does this mean?

- Testing will go back to every two weeks, with the next testing date being Thursday, March 18th.
- Resident screenings(questions, temperature, and oxygen stats) will take place 2 times a day.
- Scheduled visitations will take place in our designated visitation room located in the C POD. Please look for the **big red flag** which marks the visitation entrance. Visitors will only be able to enter and exit through the designated door and they will NOT use the regular C POD entrance door. A map is attached to this email.

Many of you have asked the same questions that we have been seeking answers to. When will the residents be able to leave campus without 14-day isolation period upon return? When will I be able to visit my loved one in their room? When can we have groups and clubs in to entertain? Trust us when we say we wish we could make these things happen. What we can do is, continue to keep your loved one safe while continuing to follow the guidance from the CDC and CMS. Your support and encouragement for the residents and staff during this pandemic has amazed us, thank you.
