Family Members,

As of this date Ransom County has six active cases of COVID-19 which has moved Ransom County into the **yellow** category. Source Control is key, and with that in mind we have updated the resident expectations for traveling off grounds. Residents have been educated that if visitation occurs in the **yellow** area, upon return a mask must be worn when out of their room and a respiratory assessment will be completed twice daily for 14 days. With the increase in cases we have also asked residents to wear a facemask when they are outside of their pod.
